Points of Common Agreement in World Religions

Generated by Snowmass Interspiritual Dialogue convened over a 30 year period with religious leaders from the major world religions

- 1. The World Religions bear witness to the Ultimate Reality, to which they give various names.
- 2. Ultimate Reality cannot be limited by any name or concept.
- 3. Ultimate Reality is the ground of infinite potentiality and actualization.
- 4. Faith is opening, responding and accepting Ultimate Reality. Faith in this sense precedes every belief system.
- 5. The potential for human wholeness-or in other frames of referenceenlightenment, salvation, transcendence, transformation, blessedness-is present in every human being.
- 6. Ultimate Reality may be experienced not only through religious practices, but also through nature, art, human relationships and service to others.
- 7. As long as the human condition is experienced as separate from Ultimate Reality, it is subject to ignorance and illusion, weakness and suffering.
- 8. Disciplined practice is essential to the spiritual life; yet spiritual attainment is not the result of one's own efforts, but the result of the experience of oneness with Ultimate Reality.
